

Exclusion clause

Valid with effect from 1.9.2020

Exclusion: Communicable diseases EETT

This insurance contract does not cover damage, liability, loss or costs directly or indirectly arising due to

- a disease or threat thereof
- preventive measures
- action taken to mitigate the consequence of a communicable disease as defined in the Communicable Diseases Act.

Examples of indirect consequences include

- The loss of customers, changes in customers' purchasing behaviours, loss of utility value of property, lost profits, reduced revenues or other financial losses
- Reputational damage.
